Anger – Sunday 27th June

Anger all around us, anger in us: hot anger, slow anger, self-righteous anger, frustrated anger. Is my anger everyone else's fault? What does it say about my heart? How does my heart need to change, and can it?

The Resurrection – Sunday 18th July

What did happen at the first Easter? And how would it have been understood? Do we see the Resurrection anticipated in the Old Testament? And what would other cultures have thought of the claim that Jesus had risen from the dead?

Gender – Sunday 12th September and Sunday 19th September

Faith & Reason – Sunday 7th November and Sunday 14th November

How do we know anything about God? How do faith and reason relate to one another, or do they not? These are not just modern questions – Christians in the Middle Ages talked about this a lot. We'll be thinking about what they have to teach us.

Anxiety – Sunday 16th January and Sunday 23rd January
